Andrew is the best-selling author of *Humor That Works: The Missing Skill for Success and Happiness at Work*, has been featured in *The Wall Street Journal*, *Forbes*, and *FastCompany*, and his TEDx talk has been viewed over 4 million times. “Taming Moisture: How to Prevent, Survive, and Solve Moisture Problems in Concrete.”

The most commonly recurring and expensive flooring-related problem is moisture. In fact, North American commercial property owners spend an estimated \$1 billion on remediation of structures and floor coverings as a result of moisture-related flooring failures annually. This course explains why more moisture problems are occurring and how moisture behaves in concrete. The course covers the ways to prevent, mitigate or solve moisture problems in concrete that eventually destroy flooring. The presentation will allow you to better understand sources and impact of moisture, and effective methods to mitigate.

Darren Ault has been the territory manager for Patcraft, the performance flooring division for Shaw Industries, for the past 6 years. He is uniquely familiar with how moisture can impact a space, especially from a flooring perspective. He is a certified CEU instructor. This presentation has been approved for CEU learning units.
